

Sample Scope & Sequence

Live Courses 2020/2021

A scope is the depth and breadth of content to be taught. A sequence is the order in which the content is to be taught. In other words, a scope & sequence is a plan of what and when to teach specific subjects and courses.

Below is a sample of courses by grade level for the 2020/2021 school year that will be taught live. (We also offer recorded courses at <https://learn.homeschoolconnections.com/unlimited-access/>)

Parents are the primary educators of their children -- you know your child best -- and so we encourage you to adjust this sample scope & sequence based on your child's special interests, academic level, etc. For example, Honor's Biology may be a better fit than Biology for a child who loves science. Conversely, Basic Chemistry may be a better fit than Chemistry for a child who struggles with science.
